The school council had their first meeting at both schools. The members got to chose a winning certificate for our certificate competition, winners will be announced shortly.

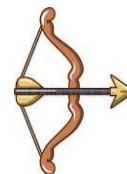
At Hilgay, Tawny Owls suggested that both schools collect crisp packets for recycling to help our planet!
