Golden Time

Each week, your child will be in competition with the class teacher and other adults in the class. If all of the children, do the right thing, the first time and quickly, then the class gets a point. If they are too slow the adults get a point! If the children have the most points by Friday then the class will be rewarded with Golden Time!

Emoji Chart

Every day, every child starts the day on the smiley face. If a child disappoints the adult with inappropriate or unacceptable behavior which doesn't follow the school rules then they will be moved to the straight face. Further disappointing behavior will result in a move to the crying face and you will be informed at the end of the day. If this is repeated, the head teacher will be informed. If it is repeated again, then you will be invited in to meet with the head teacher to discuss how we move forward. However, all children can earn the right to move back up during the day. Rarely, we see behavior that will go straight to the head teacher and you will be informed.

Family Points (pom-poms)

Your child is in a school family and they can earn points for that family by showing a good attitude, good manners, helping others, being extra polite, taking care of property or doing other nice things! These points are totaled on a Friday and the winning family receives an award. This half term the winning family will win a playtime at the park!
