Dear all,

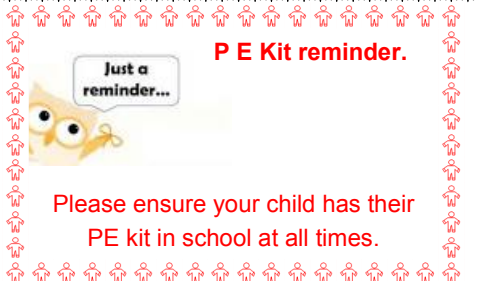
