Tri Golf

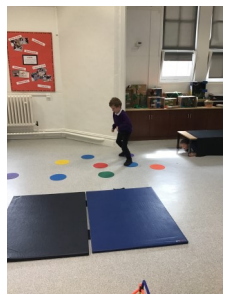
Two teams went to Runcton Holme and competed in the Tri Golf competition.
